I pray this Lent is bringing us closer to the realization of God's profound love and mercy for each one of us. As the Trappist monk and spiritual writer Thomas Merton once said, "Love is our true destiny. We do not find the meaning of life alone but with one another."

for Michigan Catholics**

**APRIL LAUNCH**

April 14 begins the first of four Biblical Training Institute conferences with keynote speaker Dr. Steve Mueller and Kathleen Sullivan, MA.

The institute is structured around a one-year program of study consisting of four Saturday conferences. The conference speakers include renowned doctors of theology, Scripture and biblical studies.

Each conference is centered on a specific topic, a scriptural theme and Scripture content followed by leadership/facilitation skills training. Biblical Formation Certificate and catechist certification credit is available to be earned.

The cost for the year long program is \$240 or \$75 per conference if not attending the full program. Pastoral staff recommendation is required.
